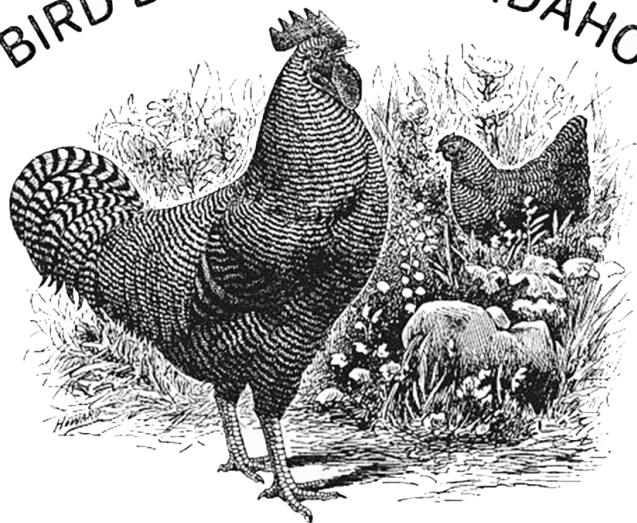

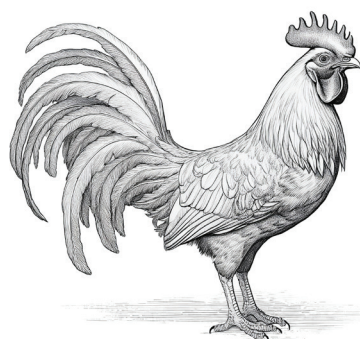

Show Rules

1. This show is run under APA and ABA rules.
2. Corrections and substitutions may be made before cooping-in. Please email Penny for corrections or substitutes treasurer@birdbreedersofidaho.org.
3. We will not accept any entry from a quarantined area.
4. We will not accept fighting cocks in our show.
5. All birds entered must stay the duration of the show.
6. Feed and water will be available, please take care of your own birds.
7. Show committee officials may remove any bird showing signs of bugs or disease and such bird will not be judged.
8. Wading pools will be available for waterfowl to clean up at the show. We only ask that you clean the pool after you use it.
9. Sales coops are available and must be pre-ordered with your entry.

Ribbons to Champion and Reserve Champion Bantam

A free listing plus a Bantam Buck is provided in the upcoming ABA Yearbook for all Best and Reserve of the seven bantam classes with a minimum of 25.

Star pins will be awarded to all wins in classes of 100 or more.

*All wins in Classes of 100 or more will be denoted with a star * and be retained in the ABA records to accumulate towards the Master Exhibitor, Master Breeder, and Lifetime Achievement awards.*

- Only ABA members are eligible to compete for the above awards.
- Dues are \$20.00 per year \$50.00 for three years.
- New members receive a copy of the quarterly and the latest available copy of the Annual American Bantam Association Year
- Book which lists many advertisers and includes a complete breed and variety index. Winners of ABA awards are listed in the year book under Who's Who in Bantams.

Starred wins are earned in classes of 100 or more in the following:

- Champions and Reserve Champions in the seven bantam divisions.
- Best and Reserve of Breed and Variety.
- Display when 7 or more bantam displays are shown.
- Best and Reserve Display when 10 or more bantam displays are shown.
- Best and Reserve Trio when 30 or more trios are shown by 4 or more exhibitors.
- A single bird is eligible for only one award and can earn only one starred win.

- Domestic fowl ONLY Chickens, Turkeys, Ducks, Geese, Peafowl or Guinea Fowl

3 Categories:

- **PORTRAIT** ~ close up of one individual in a simple setting
- **LANDSCAPE/WATERSCAPE** ~ Bird(s) in an attractive/artistic natural setting
- **ACTION** ~ Bird(s) in motion

Judging is by People's Choice, look for your "ballot tickets" in your exhibitor packet or pick them up at Secretary desk.

RULES: Photo must be taken by the person entering it. No digital enhancement. Color and Black and White compete together. Max size 8 x 10 Mount only on light weight white poster or foam core board. No frames, mats or hangers please. No lettering or numbers on the front of the photo. Put your name, Category and Division on the reverse side of the mounting board. Must be in place by 9am Saturday. Retrieving photos will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.

AWARDS: Each Division will be placed First thru Third.

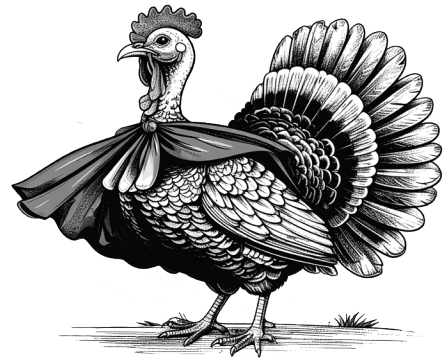

Cages will rent for \$5 each. The owner of sale birds is responsible to conduct all sales transactions. The owner must also be responsible for the birds care while they are in the sale cages.

All sales spaces must be reserved with entry before September 28, 2025.

- Only exhibitors can sell birds at the show.
- Space is first come, first served.
- Cost is \$5 per cage.

We reserve the right to require additional cages for large numbers of birds.



APA Egg Competition

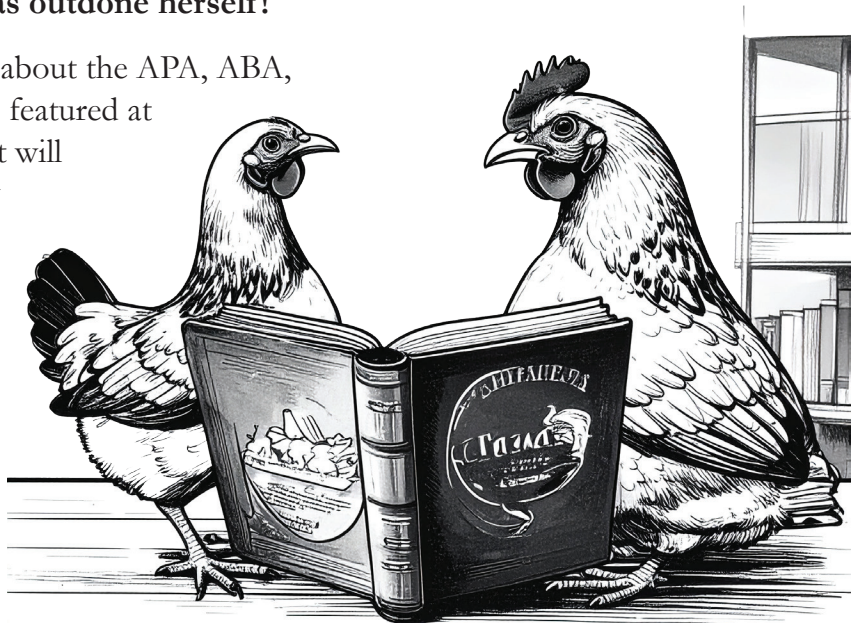

- Turn left onto Stock Trail (first left after the train tracks)
- Turn right onto S 22nd Ave.
- Turn left into the fairgrounds.

Coming from MONTANA or EASTERN IDAHO on I-15 South:

- Traveling on I-15 west, take the Twin Falls EXIT 72 where the interstate merges into I-84 west
- Take EXIT 29, turn left onto Franklin Rd.
- Continue onto S 21st Ave.
- Turn left onto Stock Trail (first left after the train tracks)
- Turn right onto S 22nd Ave.
- Turn left into the fairgrounds.

Coming from UTAH on I-84 West:

- Upon reaching Caldwell, take EXIT 29, turn left onto Franklin Rd.
